


2023 Loss Activity

U.S. 2023 Billion-Dollar Weather and Climate Events








Average Daily Global Sea Surface Temperatures - 1982-2024


Moving into Harm's Way – Florida – 1970-2020








Convective Storms - Annual Insured Loss - 1990 - 2023


U.S. Wildfires *January Through September (2000–2023)*




Reconstruction Costs - 2006-2022


Reconstruction Costs - Year-Over-Year

Reconstruction Costs - Residential - October 2022 to October 2023



Reconstruction Costs - Commercial - October 2022 to October 2023





Percentage Change in Costs




Investor provides capital to litigation funder





Litigation funder provides funding to plaintiff provides funding


















Number of Trucking Cases With Verdicts Over \$1 Million




