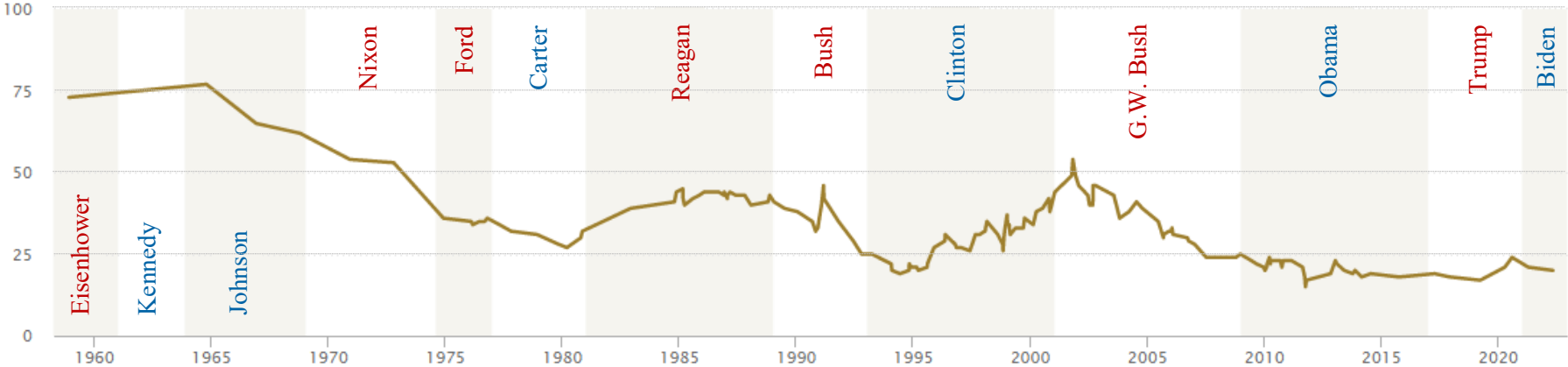

American's Confidence in U.S. Institutions Wanes

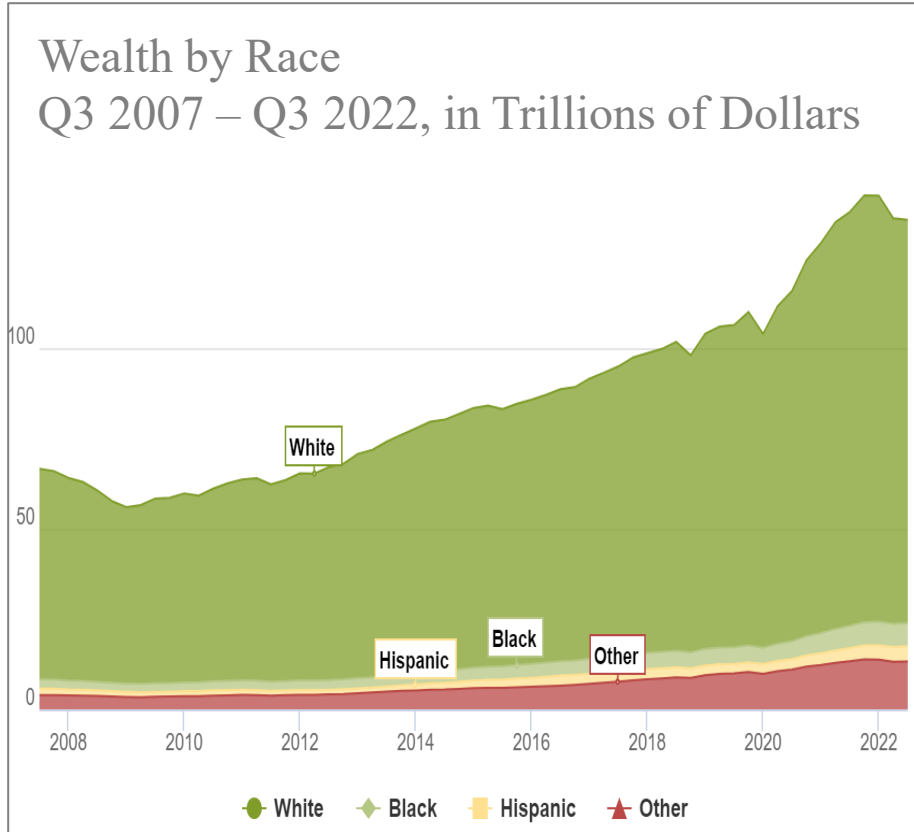

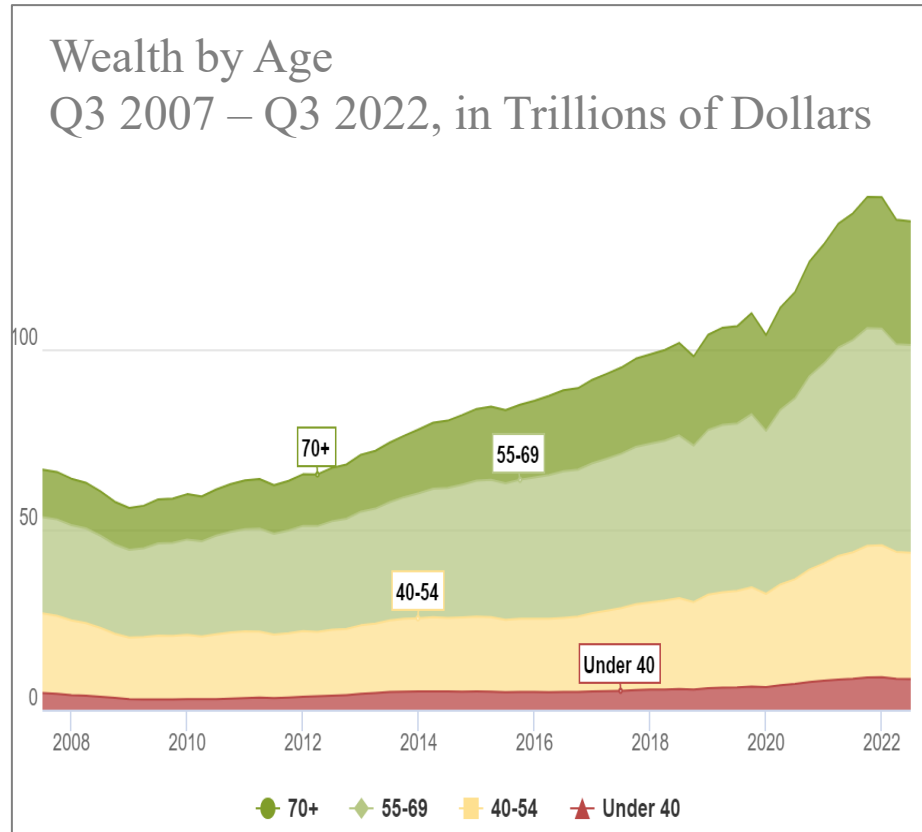
Wealth by Race

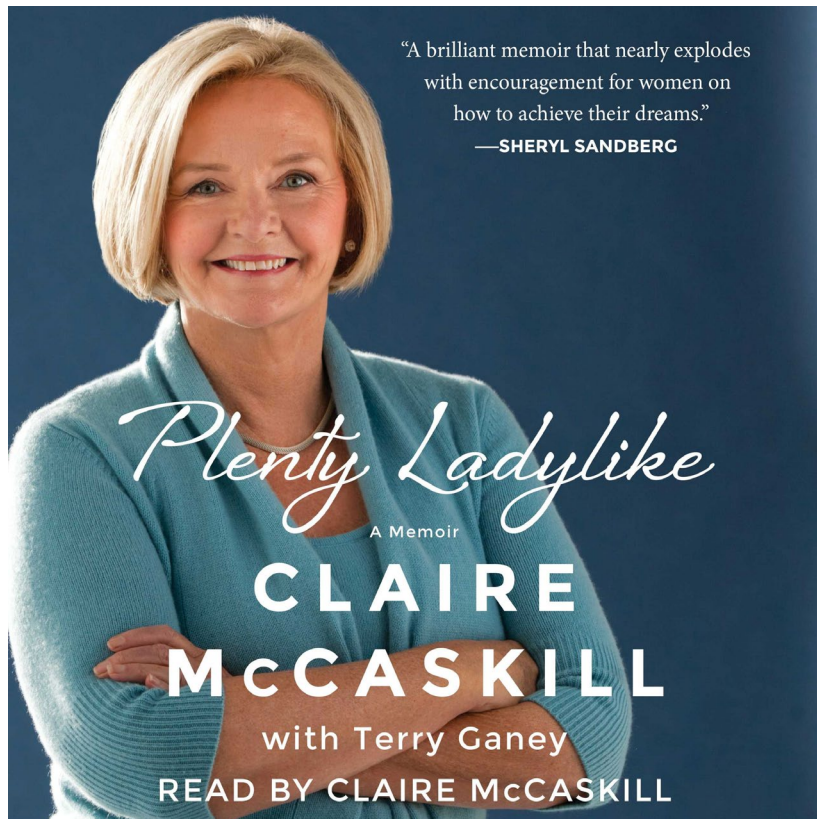
